- ❖ Extensively study and review the priorities of the church and the effectiveness of its mutual ministry at regular intervals including, when necessary, using the resources of Great Lakes Converge
- ❖ Provide spiritual direction and cohesion of vision between Oakhill Christian Church and School
- ❖ Serve on the board of Oakhill Christian School
